**FOXBORO MUSICIANS PLACE IN THE  
JUNIOR DISTRICT MUSIC FESTIVAL**

Fifteen students from Foxboro High School and Ahern Middle School were selected to participate in the Southeastern Massachusetts Junior District Festival in March. Two of the instrumentalists will occupy first chair positions in the district jazz band. Together with nineteen students chosen for Senior Districts, these musicians demonstrate the excellence and dedication for which the Foxboro music program is well known.

The purpose of the Junior District Festival, together with the Senior District and All-State Festivals, is two-fold: to provide additional music enrichment opportunities for students, and to provide a chance for musicians from all areas of the state to interact and perform together. The festivals are organized and sponsored by the Massachusetts Music Educators Association. The Southeastern Junior District Festival will be held on March 5-6, 2010, at Attleboro High School, culminating in concerts on March 6. The jazz ensemble and choruses will perform at 1:00 p.m. and the orchestra and concert band at 3:00 p.m.

Selected for the jazz band were Alex Dumont, bass, and Kevin Scollins, guitar. Students chosen for the orchestra are Christine Cavallaro, clarinet; Courtney McCue, viola; and Shane Walsh, viola. The concert band will include Ray Fuller, trumpet; John Mitchell, trombone; Erin Pearson, trumpet; and Harrison Thrasher, tuba. The mixed chorus students chosen were Max Beimler, Madeline Canfield, Aheli Chattopadhyay, Billy Clark, Allison Fisher, and Jonathan Tang.
